

FY2018 CoC Program Competition

SUMMARY

In an effort to increase Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH) to our county, it was determined that the Haven's WIN program funding would be reallocated to a new PSH project at Summit Pointe Housing. The funding decisions can be found on the website at http://www.tcccalhoun.org/funding/. This year, we also had an opportunity to apply for DV Bonus funds. Neighborhood's Inc, in partnership with SAFE Place, competed for those funds for a PH-RRH project and it was approved by the Housing Solutions Board (HSB) on 8/10/2018. All other projects were renewals. Finally, all submitted projects were reviewed and ranked by the HSB on 8/10/2018, the spreadsheet is below.

BONUS PROJECT:

Domestic Violence (DV) Bonus will provide housing and services to survivors of domestic violence, dating violence, and stalking.

• Rapid Re-housing (PH-RRH) project: Neighborhoods Inc with SAFE Place to aid those that have fallen victim to or are escaping domestic violence and have become homeless in the process.

The Coordinating Council will reapply for the planning grant funding to assist with administrative costs for the CoC Coordinator.
